

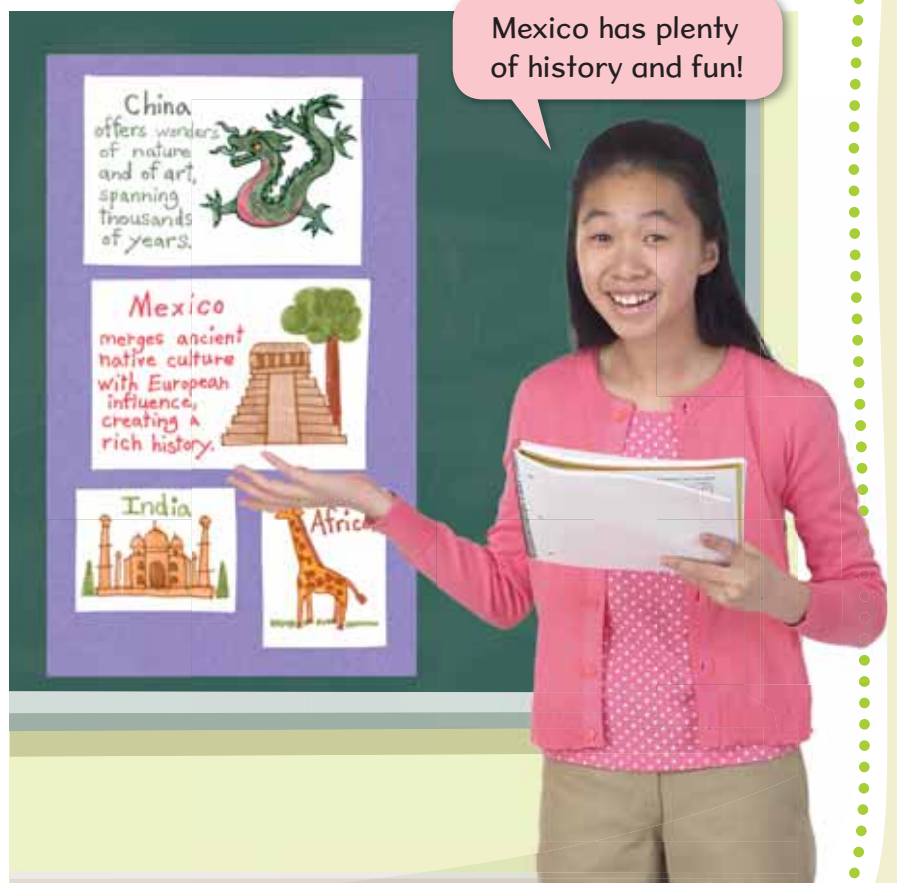
C Learn Writing a Travel Brochure
